Thank you to older generations who remember cleaner shores, and who share their stories so we can understand what has changed and why it matters.


And finally, thank you to the sea itself, always present, always changing, and always reminding us that nature is generous, but not endless.

Sometimes things we love can change, and it is okay to feel sad or confused about that. When something feels wrong, noticing it is the first step to making it better.




